The Gear May Save You (and not from what you may think)

A few weeks ago I had to get my son to pick me up from the North Shore. While I was waiting I got a text from him saying he would be late as he had to talk to the police. Needless to say I was a little concerned however he turned up about half an hour later than expected and I got to hear the whole astounding story.

I live in Titirangi so to get to the North Shore he was taking the main road past the Avondale race course and on to Great North road. He had to stop for a red light at the second set of lights on Great North. In front of him was a car then a bike at the head of the que. While waiting for the light a guy ran up to the bike, grabbed the biker and threw him and the bike to the ground. The biker tried to make a grab for the bikes key upon which the assailant whipped out a knife and slashed a piece out his helmet. The bikers leather jacket saved him from a couple more slashes and then the assailant picked up the bike and took off.

My son and the lady from the car helped the biker up and talked with him till the police arrived. As the police station is only a minute down the road they arrived quickly. They had a few things to give the police as lying on the road was the bike hijackers' knife and a shoe also the lady in the car had the presence of mind to take out her phone and start recording video as soon as the attack started. My son said there was some very clear video of the attacker's face. My son and the lady got to chat with the biker for a bit before the police arrived. He was a seventy year old and had never seen the attacker before nor had he had any sort of run in with anyone that might have been the cause. My son said the attacker was not wearing a gang patch however judging by all the tattoos he did look like your typical gang member.

So a random bike hijacking on a busy Auckland suburban street. Something that up until now I would have said was impossible.

Below is my account of a ride of a ride I did last summer. I appreciate that most Ulysseans are not in to adventure bike rides however I hope some will find it worth a read. For those that don't like it please send me an account of a ride of yours that I

Motu River Road

I spent March and April last summer riding a number of the well-known dirt roads of the south island and I have to admit that the north island does not have anything comparable. However there is one road that I would rate as being up there with the south island roads and that is the Motu river road. The Motu road runs from the small settlement of Motu across the Ruakumara range to come out just up the coast from Opotiki. The distance is about sixty kilometers however in my case I checked out some the side roads and camped by the Takaputahi river clocking up well over a hundred kilometers.

From the road name I had thought the road would run alongside the Motu river but in fact once you cross the river at the start that is the last you see of it as it runs some ten kilometers north of the road. The road runs through a bit of farm land but mostly through conservation land with mature native forest and over the ranges. Dirt roads through tall native trees are what I love and why I have an adventure bike. Unfortunately there is not a lot of native forest left. The road is single lane metal all the way and there are a couple of places where rock fall has closed the road after bad weather. There is also a stream to cross which so long as there has not been recent rain is easy enough. Meeting an oncoming vehicle at the wrong place is probably the biggest danger however I did not see a single other vehicle.

Getting to the start at the Motu end proved more time consuming than I had hoped. I was coming from Napier and the road to Gisborne had taken a beating in the cyclone. One particular section known to the locals as devil's elbow was having a huge retaining wall built and if you arrived just as the light turned red you could be in for a thirty minute wait.

I had a nice fine day in late summer for the ride and I had waited for a few days of fine weather beforehand. I figured the trip would be challenging enough without a wet road. At the start of the road the front wheel went sliding across a patch of dry clay and I was quite sure I was going down. I even had time to get down off the pegs and get my foot out but thankfully the wheel found some traction otherwise I am sure it would have ended badly.

Soon I was making good progress really loving the forest and the ranges however in the most remote part of the road is a section where the road had been covered from a rock fall. A dozer had cleared the road and I was ripping through when at the end there was a sharp right with a lot of loose stuff on the road. I was going too fast and hit the brakes. The bike slid to a halt upright and sitting on the bash plate on top of a pile of rocks at the side of the road. The front wheel at the top of a big drop and back wheel on the uphill side of the pile. Dragging the bike back off the pile started off okay but when the front wheel was on the top of the pile the bike was so high that I couldn't hold it and it slowly came down on top of me. No harm done I dragged the bike down to the road

side, removed the luggage and tried to pick it up. After a few failed attempts it was obvious I did not have the required strength. This was really annoying as the bike is not that heavy and I had picked it up a number of times before.

I sat on a rock and considered my options. Waiting for someone passing could take days. I was a long way from phone reception so start walking seemed my best hope but then it dawned on me that I was on a downhill section of road and the bikes wheels were facing uphill. So I was fighting gravity to start with. I dragged the bike through one hundred and eighty degrees adding more scratches to the crash bars but the bike was otherwise unharmed. I was then surprised at how easy the bike was to lift up.

By now it was late afternoon so I had to make good time to get to the campsite before dark. Fortunately the campsite was empty which was just as well because like many DOC campsites when the DOC websites says there are ten sites you are lucky if there is one flat grass covered one suitable for a tent. Tent up and dinner made before it got dark. A good sleep and the next day a great ride down through some rugged forest covered country to reach the main road in an hour or so and begin the long ride home.

A great ride despite a bit of a mishap. For me the best of the north island dirt roads.

For all rides, please be at the departure point 10 Minutes early with a FULL GAS TANK and an EMPTY BLADDER. If you are not sure if the run may be cancelled because of inclement weather phone the RIC before leaving home.

Ride format

SHORT: 150 km, MEDIUM: 150 - 300 km, LONG: 300 - 500 km, XTRA/LONG: Over 500 km.

CRUISE: These runs, usually monthly on a Saturday are offered at a more leisurely pace and of short distance.

ANYONE: A ride for any Club member, noting that you are to assess your own capability in relation to the RIC of the day, the destination and likely distance.

EXPERIENCED: Intended for experienced riders these are generally longer rides with less stops to regroup.

Each RIC will carry a Mobile Phone for emergencies. You will be required to provide your own details and contact details on arrival and before the ride briefing.
